# Instructions for Completing the MCR Form #803

If you are a T-Trakker or are interested in becoming one, you are invited to participate in the MCR Convention T-Trak Layout. Filling out this form begins the process of getting your module entered into the Convention Layout. You do not have to attend the Convention to participate but if so, you will miss out on the fun of building and operating on the layout you helped build.

## 1. Entrant Modeler Section

Complete the information in this section. You must be a member of the NMRA to attend the convention and so that also applies to participating in the T-Trak layout. This information will help the T-Trak Regional Modules Committee plan the layout and will also provide you with encouragement and modeling support for your module(s)

The NMRA has an inexpensive entry program called RailPass. Sign up for the one time 9-month Rail Pass trial membership for only \$19.95! Includes 9 months of NMRA Magazine, plus all regular member benefits (except voting and office holding).

Complete this section with the information for each module you are planning to enter into the Layout. Each module (or set of modules) should take one row of the form. Describe the module with the standard definitions, straight (single, double, triple), corner (outside, inside, end cap), Specialty modules (T-Junction, etc.). In the column marked track drop, identify the type of connection at the end of the drop, In the column marked Module Name do your best to describe the style of your scenery, i.e., winter scene, farm scene, urban, hillside, etc.
