
# Chuck Klein Division 4 Superintendent

We will also be at the next Midwest Railway Preservation Society open house on May 22, 12:00 - 4:00. - #2 How about a Golden Spike certificate? Our modules are 8 sq ft, the minimum size for a Golden Spike. A little electrical, a little scenery, some nice rolling stock, and you're there!!
- #1 Finally, the number one reason; to experience the joy of bringing model railroading to the community. We let the families run the trains, we talk with other model railroaders about techniques and technology, and we just show folks how much fun the hobby is.
